



# Exfoliating Mosaic Soap Bars

Colorful glycerin soap with seed powders

## Ingredients

- 1 pound (454 grams) Ultra Clear Transparent Coconut Melt & Pour Base, divided
- 1 teaspoon Almond Shell Powder
- 1 teaspoon Apricot Seed Powder
- 1 teaspoon Cherry Seed Powder
- 1 teaspoon Olive Seed Powder
- 1 teaspoon Rice Husk Powder
- 1 1/2 teaspoons (7.5 ml) Lavender Essential Oil
- 1 1/2 teaspoon (7.5 ml) Mandarin Essential Oil

This recipe makes 4 4-ounce bars

## Directions:

1. Cut 8 ounces Melt & Pour Base into cubes, then melt in double boiler over medium-high heat.
2. Remove the base from heat, then mix in the Lavender Essential Oil.
3. Pour 3 tablespoons (45 ml) base into small mixing vessel and add the Almond Shell Powder. Pour the base and seeds into a soap mold. Repeat this step with the remaining melted base and exfoliants.
4. Cut the remaining 8 ounces of Melt & Pour Base into cubes, then melt in double boiler over medium-high heat.
5. When the exfoliant soaps have hardened, remove them from the mold and cut into small slivers and chunks. Divide the cut pieces randomly between 4 4-ounce soap mold cavities.
6. Remove the base from heat, then mix in the Mandarin Essential Oil. Pour the melted base into the 4 soap mold cavities.
7. Allow the soaps to cool and harden completely before removing them from the molds.

## Usage & Packaging:

- Once cool, these soaps should be packaged in airtight plastic. Plastic wrap, shrink wrap, or cellophane bags are great choices.
- The finished bars can last up to one year, depending on how well they've been packaged and stored. Soaps should be kept in a cool, dry place for long-term storage.
